I have the honour to refer to a letter dated 29 July 1947 from the Acting Secretary-General to the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization in which UNESCO was authorized to utilize the assets of the former International Institute of Intellectual Co-operation, which had been transferred by the League of Nations to the United Nations, on the understanding that these assets would be used for the purpose of ensuring the continuity of the work performed by the former Institute.

These assets included the publications of the former Institute and I now take pleasure in authorizing UNESCO not only to utilize the publications but also to make such other disposition of these publications and any copyright interest that may be attached thereto, in such manner as it may see fit, in furtherance of its general obligation of continuing the work performed by the former Institute.
