INSTRUMENT OF ACCEPTANCE

WHEREAS the Constitution of the United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization was adopted by the Conference for the establishment of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization held in London from 1 to 16 November 1945.

WHEREAS the said Constitution was amended by the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization at its various sessions.

WHEREAS it is provided in Article IV of the Constitution that it shall be subject to acceptance.

NOW THEREFORE the Government of Republic of Maldives having considered the aforesaid Constitution as amended, hereby accept the same and undertake faithfully to carry out all the stipulations therein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Fathulla Jameel, Minister of External Affairs of the Government of the Republic of Maldives, have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal.

WHEREAS the Instrument of Acceptance of the Constitution of the said Organisation by the Government of the Republic of Maldives has, in accordance with Article IV, already been deposited with the Government of Her Britannic Majesty in the United Kingdom, and,

WHEREAS Article XV of the Constitution of the said Organisation stipulates that the formality of the signature on behalf of every member-country must be completed,

NOW THEREFORE THESE PRESENTS ARE TO CERTIFY that His Excellency Ahmed Zaki, the Permanent Representative of the Republic of Maldives to the United Nations has been duly named, constituted and appointed by the Government of Maldives as its plenipotentiary and representative having full power and authority to sign the said Constitution for and on behalf of the Republic of Maldives.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Fathulla Jameel, Minister of External Affairs of the Republic of Maldives have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal.
